Ecclesiastes 10:19 "A feast is made for laughter, wine makes life merry, and money is the answer for everything." NIV

Where there is collection, raising and exchange of funds, multiple stakeholders like government, tax administrations, reserve bank, financial conduct institutions, sponsors / donors and beneficiaries start to have interest in processes, procedures and governance of such to align with statutes / laws.

Mat 25:15-21 – the master expected and demanded servants to account on what they were given,

These then dictate for at least six things to happen:

I. System Design and Planning

- 1. Define objectives: Clearly outline the vision, mission (purpose), goals, and scope of the mission about the funding system.
- 2. Establish governance: Form a governing board or committee to oversee the funding system.
- 3. Develop policies: Create policies for fund management, distribution, and reporting.
- 4. Design a secure electronic platform: Utilize a secure platform for fund management, tracking, and reporting with proper audit trail.

II. Fund Management and Distribution

- 1. Create a centralized fund management system: Establish a single, centralized system for managing funds.
- 2. Designate fund administrators: Appoint administrators to manage and distribute funds.
- 3. Develop a fund distribution plan: Establish a plan for distributing funds to missionaries and mission projects.
- 4. Implement a system for tracking and reporting: Utilize a system for tracking fund distribution and reporting on fund usage.

III. Accountability and Transparency

- 1. Establish financial reporting requirements: Require regular financial reports from fund recipients.
- 2. Conduct regular audits: Perform regular audits to ensure financial integrity.
- 3. Implement a whistle-blower policy: Establish a policy for reporting financial irregularities.
- 4. Maintain transparency: Ensure that financial information is accessible and transparent.

IV. Compliance and Risk Management

- 1. Comply with laws and regulations: Ensure compliance with relevant laws, regulations, and tax requirements.
- 2. Assess and mitigate risks: Identify and mitigate potential risks associated with fund management and distribution.

- 3. Develop a risk management plan: Establish a plan for managing risks and addressing potential issues.
- 4. Maintain adequate insurance coverage: Ensure adequate insurance coverage for fund management and distribution activities.

V. Training and Capacity Building

- 1. Provide training for fund administrators: Offer training for fund administrators on financial management, reporting, and compliance.
- 2. Develop capacity-building programs: Establish programs to build the capacity of missionaries and mission organizations in financial management and reporting.
- 3. Conduct regular workshops and seminars: Host regular workshops and seminars on financial management, reporting, and compliance.

VI. Monitoring and Evaluation

- 1. Establish a monitoring and evaluation framework: Develop a framework for monitoring and evaluating the effectiveness of the funding system.
- 2. Conduct regular monitoring and evaluation: Regularly monitor and evaluate the funding system to identify areas for improvement.
- 3. Make adjustments and improvements: Make adjustments and improvements to the funding system based on monitoring and evaluation findings.

BASICS FOUNDATIONAL ITEMS:

- Establish your Biblical basis of your missionary element and support
- Overcome your giants when thinking and considering missions work
- Earnestly pray as you plan on budget and those you are identifying as potential supporters (individuals & entities) as you rank them on perceived possibility to give.
- Identify people who believe in your course and create a personal engagement to ask for support (those with love accompanied by giving: Wonderful Giving Church 2 Cor 8:1 2 Generosity (Philippians 1; 4: 10).
- Let those be a team who can help to fund or raise funds on your behalf
- Be willing and ready to account back and regular communication of updates and feedback.
- Consider the possibility of also be tent-makers (Skills Capability to support your mission).
- Verify the old saying on those to embark on missions: Repentance Holy Spirit Conviction Burden for the lost (WHY) "set themself alight"
- Money does not come from the wealthy The widow story
- Mission is not only going across the border as such is coming to where we are
- Neighbouring countries should be encouraged e.g. South Africa, Mozambique, Zimbabwe, Zambia, Namibia, Angola, can ensure that they hear more about each other so that their needs can be known and be met.
- Need to create heart of mission sustainability
